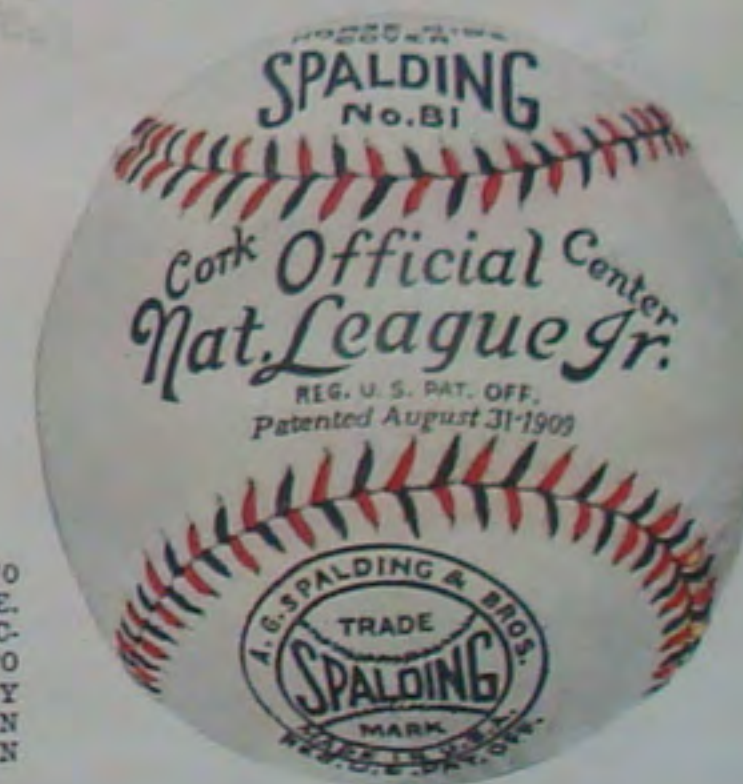

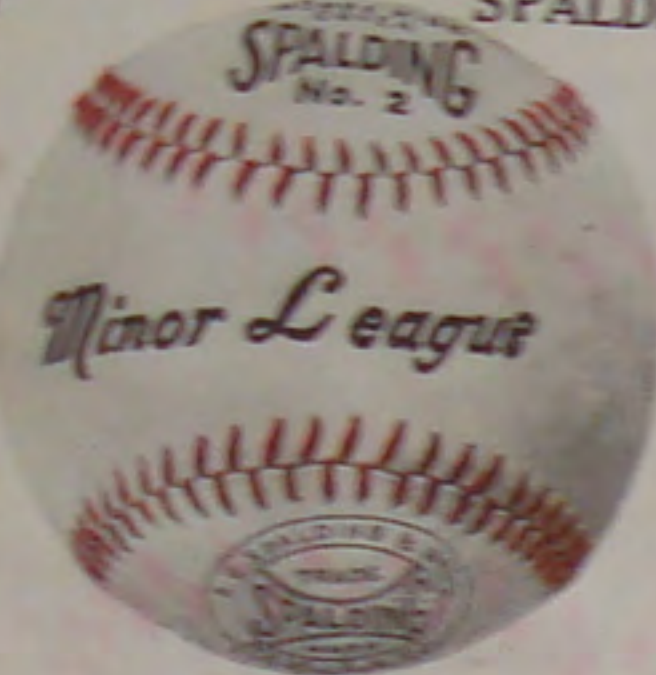

If you have any particular model of bat which you wish made up or an old bat that you want duplicated, special attention will be given to your order if complete specifications are sent to any A. G. SPALDING & BROS. Store, accompanied by the price, \$1.65. The bat will be made and finished according to your specifications, either in the "Professional" oil finish or the "Gold Medal" natural finish. If the old bat is sent it should be expressed, charges prepaid, with your name and address on the package, and also on tag attached to bat. If only measurements are sent, special care should be used in drawing the bat on a blank sheet of paper, giving the exact shape of the bat with measurements around different parts and the length and the approximate weight. At least five ounces variation in weight must be allowed for difference in density of timber.

WE REQUIRE AT LEAST TWO WEEKS' TIME FOR THE EXECUTION OF SPECIAL BAT ORDERS. Spalding Bats improve with age if properly cared for. Bats made specially to order should not be used for at least thirty (30) days after they are finished, to give ample time for the oil finish to thoroughly harden. Players should make it a rule to have two or more bats in reserve at all times.

The whole process of repadding is very simple, requiring no special skill and only a few minutes' time. When building up padding around the little finger, the heel and the thumb, special care must be taken not to extend padding too close to palm of glove, as this would materially interfere with deep pocket which is an important feature of these gloves. 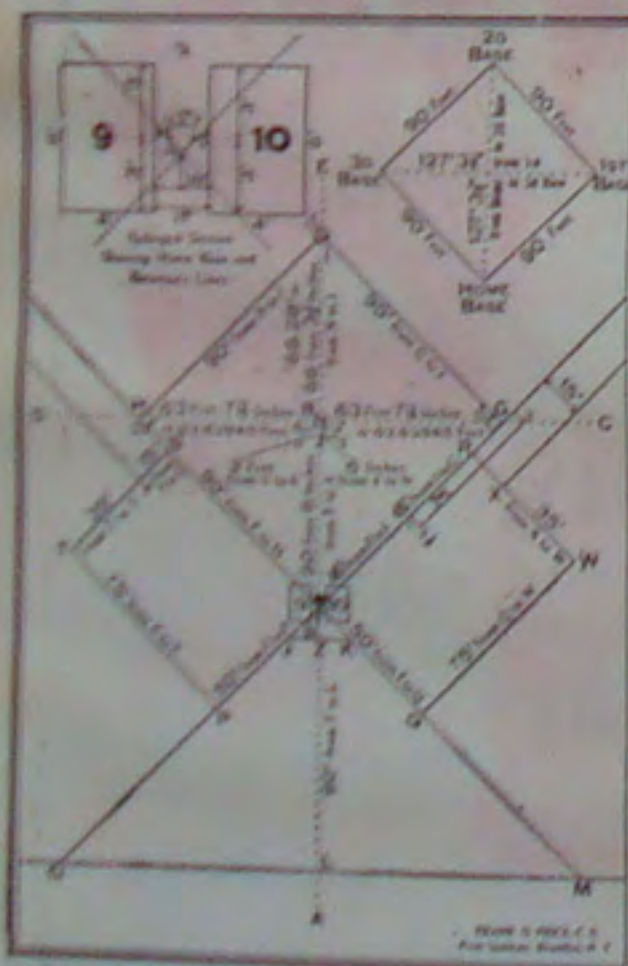

HOW TO LAY OUT A BASE BALL DIAMOND

FIRST—Select a level stretch of ground, as free from stones, hills and hollows as possible and at least 300 feet square. If the ground is well grassed over, so much the better.

SECOND—With a steel tape measure lay out the base lines and place the home plate and pitcher's box as shown in the diagram. If it is possible to do so, have the home plate due north and the pitcher's box due south.

THIRD—Remove the sod from the base lines between the home plate and first and third bases. Remove the sod from around pitcher's box. Fill in the base lines and pitcher's box with soil and level down solid.

FOURTH—Put up backstop 90 feet behind home plate and 8 feet high, and if you have plenty of time and timber it doesn't hurt to have a small grandstand with seats which need not have backs, nor be made of planed boards. Don't put the stand or stands too close, give the catcher at least 50 feet on either side to handle foul flies and wild throws. Build a players' bench.

HOW TO LAY OUT A TENNIS COURT

From Spalding's Lawn Tennis Manual. Price 25 Cents.



As a double court practically includes every line to be found in a single court, it is best to take first the measure for the latter. Having determined the position of your net, place in the ground, in the line shown, two pegs 27 feet apart (at the points A and B, in the diagram). Then take two measurements and stretch them respective ends to the points A and B. On the line, which will measure the diagonal of the court, take a length of 41 feet 3 inches, on the other 39 feet 3 inches, and in each direction there is three feet more than is given. This will give you center of the court. At that point, C, 21 feet from A, put a peg to mark the end of the service line. The other corner, D, and the other end of the service line, E, may be found by measuring the corners and extending the ground. The same measurements on the other side of the net will complete the square boundaries of the court. By prolonging the line A-B 4 feet 6 inches in each direction, and joining the four new points thus obtained, we can make the side lines of a double court.

It is necessary to mark the service line. This is done by joining the middle points of the service lines. If a double court alone be required, the service side-line need not be prolonged to meet the line line. Remember that in all cases the out-post must stand at a distance of three feet from the side line.

For a court where a single or double game can be played, the size is 78 feet in length by 36 in width, 41 1/2 feet inside the side lines, and parallel with them are drawn the service lines. See diagram below.

Remember given instructions for building tennis courts, correct dimensions, etc., and free upon request.

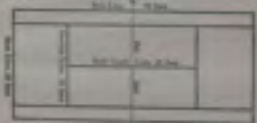


Diagram of Single and Double Courts.

HOW TO SELECT YOUR GOLF CLUBS

THE first thing to be noted generally and held the club normally. The weight depends greatly upon your muscular control and general ability; you will probably require about a pound before you discover the weight of the club which will give maximum results.
