Using a hot-glue gun and leather from his wife's old purses, Hayes experimented with various designs. In 1988 he went to Taiwan to explore manufacturing possibilities, and Edison ap-pealed to the Word of Truth congregapealed to the Word of Truth congrega-tion for a "faith investment" to get the project going. More than half of the con-gregation's 1.700 members responded, contributing \$100,000 in start-up funds. Since then, Hayes says, more than \$300,000 has been invested.

won't be knocked off by hard-hit balls.
