












1926 Leo "Gabby" Hartnett JC Higgins 1636 Catchers Mitt






Early 1900's Crescent Pad Adjustable Heel Catchers Mitt

Early crescent catchers mitt most likely a D&M but no discernible markers are visible. The crescent pad is extremely protruded. The lining feels great on the hand. All the original rivets are in nice condition. There are some period stitch repairs on the top perimeter but not visible except from the top. There are some scuffs and scrapes but overall the mitt is solid with no major damage, just wear. This is a nice mitt.....\$300





No. 90. This Mitt is manufactured of the celebrated asbestos calfskin, which does not harden by wetting. It is sewed with the best quality of linen thread, waxed, padded with the best asbestos felt, and has patent laced thumb, and patent lacing for repadding. The thumb and fingers are protected by a rubber guard, and the heel of the Mitt is raised, forming a deep pocket. Has the reinforcement, which covers the seams between the thumb and the

hand, preventing all possibility of ripping. It is soft and pliable

1950's Mickey Mantle Rawlings XPGH Heart of the Hide Personal Model Glove

The real deal USA model! Produced only in 1968 in limited numbers, very few Mickey Mantle XPGHs have survived or ever come up for sale. Even fewer in this condition, given its fragility. Almost an exact replica of Mantle's outfielder's glove down to the super rare spiral web he was famous for. This particular gem is EX+ with all original lacing, sharp stampings of Mantle's signature in the pocket and HOH stamp, and a fine Rawlings label. Possibly, the finest example extant.



Also included are a rare signed photo of him wearing the model (PSA/DNA LOA), a 1964 Sport magazine with Ozzie Sweet's photo of Mantle posing with the glove, a vintage 8" x 10" print of the Sweet photo licensed by Mantle's sons (LOA), and a short history of the model.

A close to mint example of the very common XPG6 recently was recently flipped on eBay for \$2,295. Be a Barry Halper!.....\$3,250





Offering a host of vintage baseball glove restoration services to clean, preserve, soften, and uncover the leather grain and stampings:

Services include:

- Cleaning: leather inside and out, silk tags, grommets, buttons and buckles
- Dirt, rocks, and debris removal from inside finger stalls
- Re-conditioning: Various methods used based upon the type, quality, and condition of the leather in order to minimize/prevent darkening
- Fixing broken laces (relacing) & lacing when laces are missing (I have 30-40 lbs. of vintage laces I use to color and style match when possible)
- Removing Ink, paint, and other substances (some I can completely remove, others partially)
- Fixing minor rips, tears and holes (various sewing methods, leather glues, and/or color-matched leather repair compounds) on outside of leather and some areas of liner (palm, bottom of where fingers connect; finger stalls are not usually possible for repair)
- Piping touch up (color matched) to prevent further deterioration
- *I do not replace liners or piping, nor do I stain or change leather colors to misrepresent the glove differently than it was manufactured.

I work to keep gloves as original as possible with the goal to preserve and protect them for the next generation. Every glove is different, and some are better candidates than others based upon their condition and leather quality. I have cleaned, restored, and/or repaired more than 100 of my own gloves (and many for other collectors) in the past 5 years, and would love to help you. I have a dedicated workbench with the right tools and materials and work on a few gloves each week. Prices are reasonable. I would love to help you.


